### SOME HIGHLIGHTS

- Since 2001, 23 annual education conferences have been held, serving 4,600 attendees.



- 494 students have received the Christina Diaz Student Scholars Awards (Grades K-12 & College)
- 190 students have received scholarships, for a total of over \$62,800 in distributed funds.
- 66 educators received the Sevia Ma'ae Educator Award, 73 community partners the Dr. Alofa Tanuvasa Community Award, and 3 Counselors received our new Sala Auelua Counselor Award.

- The Falana'i Ala Speaker and Mentor series reaches 1,500 elementary, middle school and high school and college students annually.
